Zebra Means Green!

Every now and then we're asked this question:
Why don't you sell biocides?

Simple. Biocides are bad for you. They are designed to kill bacteria and fungi, but they are also very good at damaging human cells. That's why their use is very carefully controlled, and why you only need a teaspoon to treat a sump of 100 gallons (378 liters).

Don't get us wrong. Most chemicals are helpful. On the other hand, it was only a few decades ago that coolants like Trimsol were incredibly popular because they would last forever. Tramp oils disappeared and bugs never grew. Of course, it turned out that the chemicals in Trim could also cause cancer. So by the mid 70s these chemicals were outlawed, and organically based coolants came to the market.

Rather than getting on the bandwagon, Zebra takes the conservative approach. Clean your machine using time-tested methods of alkaline cleaners, bleach, water, and elbow-grease. Slow down the natural course of nature by keeping tramp oils (the food for bacteria) out of the sump, keep it aerated and moving, and keep the coolant in the zone.
